#### President's Corner

After a long, cold winter, summer is finally here. As many of you know, the Wright's Beach boat ramp was damaged this past October after heavy rain storms while the lake was lowered. The erosion of the ramp was caused by the repaving of Route 114 last summer and Andrews Brook jumping its banks and water flowing onto the lower portion of the boat ramp.

Last fall, I spoke to a civil engineer, the NH Department of Environmental Services, and a contractor to explore our options for repairing the ramp and preventing similar erosion in the future.

The BLPA Board met on May 25, 2019 to discuss the next steps in making the necessary repairs to the ramp. We are currently meeting with additional contractors and engineers to determine the best course of action for a permanent repair to the ramp. In the interim, the boat ramp access gate has been temporarily widened so boats can be launched without using the damaged portion of the ramp. Please be sure to launch your boat south of the ramp, as there is a narrow gulley and sand bar immediately in front of the existing ramp.

The Executive Committee will provide an update of our efforts to address this issue at our Annual Meeting scheduled for July 27<sup>th</sup>. We hope to see you there.

Pursuant to the BLPA By-Laws, the lake was lowered last fall to inspect and maintain the dam and for the convenience of the membership. The project was a success, issues with the boat ramp on Wright's Beach notwithstanding.

A heartfelt thanks to the folks who volunteered to clear a considerable amount of debris off the dam last September. With the debris cleared and the lake lowered, the dam showed no signs of disrepair. The culvert that we feared might need rebuilding was merely clogged. The dam was pressure washed and resurfaced with two coats. The beavers appear to have moved on and the lake was back to normal levels by mid-November. # Remembering Don Wright

(1913 - 2019)

Captain Donald G. Wright passed away on April 9, 2019 in Ventura, CA at the amazing age of 105. Don was born in Sutton, NH on November 11, 1913 to Chester (Chet) Wright and Ola (Gay) Wright, the venerable vaudeville family that settled on the shores of Blaisdell Lake in the early part of



the twentieth century. Don was the elder brother of Estelle (Wright) Rooney, who operated the legendary Dog House restaurant with husband Pat Rooney from 1948 - 1984 on the Wright family property adjacent to Chet's general store and vaudeville museum.

Don is survived by his wife Elaine (Freeman) and predeceased by his wife Barbara Helen (Michaud)

who passed in 1985. Don had a distinguished 25-year Army career, retiring as a Captain in 1957. He was honored for his service just three years ago on his Veterans Day birthday at age 102, during which Don looked back on "My First 100 Years" including a glimpse at his life growing up in Sutton in the early 1900's.

Don also had a career as a zoning inspector for the County of Ventura, retiring in 1976. He was proud to be a Mason for over 75 years. Don is also survived by daughter Sandra Harrison of Trinidad, Colorado; son Donald Wright II (wife Janet) of San Luis Obispo, CA; daughter Carol Coert (husband Lewis) of Ventura and Susan Westover (husband Wally) of Ventura.
