## BLAISDELL LAKE PROTECTIVE ASSOCIATION BOAT LAUNCH ACCESS CODE EXPECTATIONS

- 1. Do not share your personal code with anyone else, including neighbors, renters, etc.
- 2. Do not remove the lock from the beach
- 3. Do not willfully damage the lock
- 4. Do not misuse the boat launch access
- 5. Abide by the Weed Watch rules to avoid bringing harmful invasive species to the lake
- 6. Make sure your friends/family who visit and launch a boat from Wright's Beach will abide by the Weed Watch rules to avoid bringing harmful invasive species to the lake
- 7. Lock the gate behind you every time you open it with your personal code
- 8. Report any lock issues (misuse, damage, technical issues) to the BLPA Board immediately
- 9. If you believe an unauthorized person is using your personal code, please notify the BLPA Board so your code can be cancelled and you can be issued a new personal code
- 10. If you sell your home on the lake during the 2021 Summer season please notify the BLPA Board so your personal code can be deactivated

The Blaisdell Lake Protective Association will periodically check a digital log of who has accessed the gate lock and when to ensure it is being used properly and that non-member boats are being inspected prior to launch.
