Wright's Beach Boat Launch Lock Instructions

Dear BLPA Member,

Thank you for requesting a pin code to unlock the Wright's Beach boat launch gate. At any time throughout the year you may use the pin code on your membership card to unlock the gate <u>and lock it</u> <u>behind you</u>. Below are instructions for using the lock.

TO UNLOCK

- 1) Press any button on the keypad to "wake up" the device
- 2) Type your pin code, followed by the Unlock icon (bottom right)
- 3) The light will flash green twice, with four short tones once unlocked
- 4) Pull the shackle to open

AUTO LOCK

The lock is programmed to lock automatically once the shackle is closed.

- 1) Simply close the shackle
- 2) Once the light flashes green, followed by a long beep, it is locked

MANUAL LOCK

If auto lock isn't working you can manually lock it.

- 1) Once you close the shackle, press and hold the Unlock icon for two seconds
- 2) The light will flash green, followed by a long beep

JUMPSTART THE BATTERY

In the event that the battery has died, you can power the lock temporarily with a 9V battery. These instructions - along with diagrams - will also be located in the beach mailbox for your reference.

- 1) Find the 9V battery in the beach mailbox
- 2) Touch and hold the battery connects against the battery pins located on the bottom of the lock
- 3) While holding the 9V battery to the pins, press your pin code, followed by the Unlock icon
- 4) Please alert the Weed Watch volunteer on duty via text or phone call at (781) 281-9980.

Please note that the lock has a silicone covering that should remain on the lock at all times. This is to protect the lock and prevent water damage. Once you press any button to wake up the lock, the numbers will light up and make it easier to see the numbers as you input your code.

As of May 1, 2021 additional instructions and troubleshooting information will be located both in the beach mailbox and on the BLPOA.org website. Should you encounter trouble with the lock - or notice that the battery is running low - please call/text the Weed Watch volunteer on duty at (781) 281-9980.
